**Re: Year 2MC London Eye/Riverboat Trip 2023**

Currently Year 2 are learning about the topic London and on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October 2023, Woodpeckers (2MC) will be travelling into London to look at the sights.

This trip will provide a context to the children's learning, as we will be taking them on the London underground to Westminster Station. Once there, we will ride the London Eye and a Riverboat Cruise to see the key landmarks of our capital city.

In previous years, those pupils who had travelled on the underground and visited these landmarks made accelerated progress in many areas of the curriculum. Gaining knowledge of the capital city is a life-long skill too.
