Monday 16th October: Reception, Nursery & Atlantis/Apollo Room

Please ensure your child's money (£20 maximum) is supplied in a sealed envelope/bag marked with the **child's name** and **class.** 

We will also bring the book trolleys out to the KS1 and KS2 playground at home time (weather permitting) on each of these days. Alongside this, we will also have some 2<sup>nd</sup> hand book tables. These will consist of books that no longer fit the reading schemes within the school but which could still be used at home to support your child. All donations received will be put back into buying new books for our children.
