
Literacy



We will be learning how to communicate our emotions using emotive vocabulary and will then become authors by making a class book based on the text The Colour Monster.

We will be focusing on:

- developing our vocabulary to talk about different emotions
- talk about previous experiences where we have felt a range of emotions
- to orally compose a sentence before writing
- to use our phonic knowledge to help us spell unknown words
- to write a sentence- using a capital letter to begin the sentence, use finger spaces between words and a full stop at the end of the sentence.

We will then learn about rhythm and rhyme through the text, Oi Frog. We will develop our knowledge and understanding of rhyming words and use this to generate our own rhymes.

PSHE

We are learning about 'family and Relationships'.

We will be:

- learning what PSHE stands for and how to behave in these lessons
- understanding what a family is
- learning the importance and characteristics of positive friendships
- recognising how others show emotions and how to respond
- learning how to work with others
- learning how to overcome problems we may experience in our friendships
- understanding what is meant by a stereotype



Science

We are learning about 'Everyday Materials'. We will be:

- identifying a variety of everyday materials, such as, wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock
- sorting materials according to how they look and feel
- using vocabulary to describe the properties of a material
- investigating the properties of different papers
- identifying and naming a variety of fabrics
- testing how materials bend and stretch
- exploring the properties of absorbency and waterproofing.

RE

We are learning about Christianity.

We will be:

- exploring what we already know about Christianity
- talking about groups that we belong to and explore the meaning of 'belonging'
- talking about what Christians believe
- exploring and talking about objects that are special to Christians, such as the Bible and Cross
- describing the features of a church
- learning what happens in a church
- visiting a church to discuss the different parts

PE

In Athletics with Mr Hoyte we will be:

 learning how to perform a standing long and triple jump using technique

learning the sprint technique

With our class teacher, we will be:

- learning how to coordinate our footwork to perform
- learning how to perform a static balance on one leg

Music

We will be:

- learning how to use our speaking and singing voice developing into a rapping voice
- using tuned percussion to accompany a simple melody
- performing a hip-hop style song

DT and Art

In DT we will be:

• learning about fruit and vegetables- tasting and making a fruit smoothie

In Art we will be:

- exploring primary and secondary colours
- exploring work by the artist Jasper Johns
- using our knowledge of colour mixing to painta colour circle.
