

Introduction

The admission authority for Beam County Primary School is the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham. These arrangements are in line with the School Admissions Code 2021 and designed to ensure there is a fair admissions procedure for all applicants.

These arrangements will apply to all admissions from September 2025 including in-year admissions.

1. Published admissions number

For the school year commencing September 2025 the published admissions number (PAN) is 28 for entry into classes in Reception to Year 6.

1.1 Applying for a place

Beam County School welcomes all applications. The relevant entry years are reception, year 1, year 2, year 3, year 4, year 5, and year 6. The school is a mixed-sex school.

Parents must notify the school immediately if there are any changes that may affect their child's application, such as a change of address.

Children outside of chronological age group

Parents may apply for a place in a year outside of their child's chronological age group. Parents are advised to contact the school prior to application to discuss the reasons why such a place is required and obtain advice on the evidence that may be required to support such a request. Applications for admission outside of the normal age group should be sent to the admissions officer at nfos@lbbd.gov.uk or admissions@lbbd.gov.uk for consideration by the Local Authority. Admission arrangements are set by admission authorities. The council is the admissions authority for all community schools in this borough. Any decision taken by the admissions authority will be based on what is in the best interests of the child concerned after all the evidence and the views of the headteacher have been considered.

Parents are encouraged to visit the school with their child if they are planning to apply for a place, this can be arranged through the school office.
