Inspire World of Work Week at Beam County Primary School-2024

Between the 3rd – 7th June, your child will be taking part in Inspire's World of Work Week programme in partnership with Beam County Primary School. This is a week-long, careersfocused learning programme, during which students will learn about a variety of different careers sectors through participating in various exciting workshops and activities. Additionally, each year group will either go on a trip or have a volunteer-led workshop at school. Our WoW programme aims to increase students' aspirations, challenge stereotypes and break down barriers to learning about the world of work. It will also allow students to develop various transferable skills that will benefit their learning within the classroom beyond World of Work Week.

The themes for this year's World of Work Week are as follows:

Nursery: My First Job

Students are introduced to the World of Work and explore the following professions through role play, dress-up and other interactive activities: Police Officer, Doctor, Builder, Shop Keeper.

Reception: Jobs with Nature

Students learn about jobs that involve working with the natural world: Gardener, Vet, Farmer and Zoologist.

Year 1: Robots & Machines

Students learn about several jobs within the Engineering field: Robotics Engineer, Civil Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Biomedical Engineer.

Year 2: Community Jobs

Students learn about several jobs that have an important place within our local communities and involve services to the public: High Street Jobs, Health Jobs, Fixing Jobs and Fitness Jobs.

Year 3: Building Futures

Students learn about jobs involved in working within the built environment, including the fields of Architecture, Construction and Engineering. Sustainability is a key theme throughout.

Year 4: Showcase

Students learn about jobs within the theatre and performing arts industries, including jobs both on and off stage: Screen Writer, Set Designer, Lighting Technician, Performer

Year 5: Ethical Business

Students learn about what it means to run an ethical business and work in groups over the course of the week, taking on different job roles and designing their very own ethical businesses.

Year 6: Tech Masters

Students learn about a variety of jobs within the technology field, using their learning about business and technology to work in groups to design their very own phone apps.
