On Thursday 28th & Friday 29th November 2024 Year 6 have been lucky enough to secure a Science company to hold a 'forensic workshop'. The children will find this very informative and exciting as part of the National Curriculum for science and history.

The children will be looking at ways to see how Science is applied in the 'real-world'.
