Year 6 Trip to Southend

We have organised a visit to Southend for Tuesday 8th July. This is an end of year special treat for year six. This is a celebration because the children have worked so hard this year.

We, the school, are able to buy 'wrist bands' for the rides at a reduced cost, and the school will be paying most of the cost. We are asking for a contribution of £26.00 which must be paid via your child's Parentpay account - **Southend Trip Year 6 2025**. If your child does not have a Parentpay account, please call the office for an activation letter to set one up.

The coach will be leaving at 9 a.m. prompt and we will return for 4:15 p.m. (please ensure your child is in school promptly at 8.30 a.m. for registration).

Lunch will be provided however you can supply your child with some snacks and plenty to drink (no glass bottles) in a disposable bag and if you wish, an optional £10 spending money for ice cream / extra drinks and treats. To help identify the pupils whilst at Southend please can they wear their **red Beam Leavers T-Shirt** (which will be given to the pupils before the day), alongside suitable outdoor clothing for this trip and trainers. Please supply a rain-proof jacket/sun-cream & hat if it is very hot (put on before coming to school).

Children must bring a small beach towel (in a bag). However, children will be responsible for carrying these, therefore a small backpack would be suitable (please ensure all items have your child's name written on the label). We cannot take responsibility for items that are misplaced or damaged.
